

SEI Group Inc., one of five small businesses awarded an indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (ID/IQ) contract by the U.S. Army Engineering and Support Center, Huntsville, Alabama

This past November, the U.S. Army Engineering and Support Center located in Huntsville, Alabama announced the award of an Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (ID/IQ) contract to SEI Group Inc., one of five small businesses, to provide Electronic Security Systems (ESS) and related services. The estimated total capacity for all contractors is \$200 million dollars over five (5) years.

SEI will provide world-wide ESS services which includes: developing installation engineering plans; procuring and manufacturing of hardware and software; performing system testing and check-out; performing minor facility modifications; interfacing and installing new data transmission equipment; determining compatibility of new equipment with existing systems; preparing system and component documentation; providing operation and maintenance manuals; providing ESS training; warranting systems; maintaining and servicing systems; operating and monitoring systems; and providing as-built installation drawings; plus, providing electronic control and data acquisition systems services, such as Utility Monitoring and Control Systems (UMCS).

Mr. Eloy Torrez, President, SEI Group Inc., stated in a press release announcing the award "This contract represents an enormous opportunity for SEI in the security services business, and it allows us to assist the Huntsville Engineering and Support Center mission to secure our nation."
